

# Taxonomy of Educational Outcomes

## Interpersonal Domain

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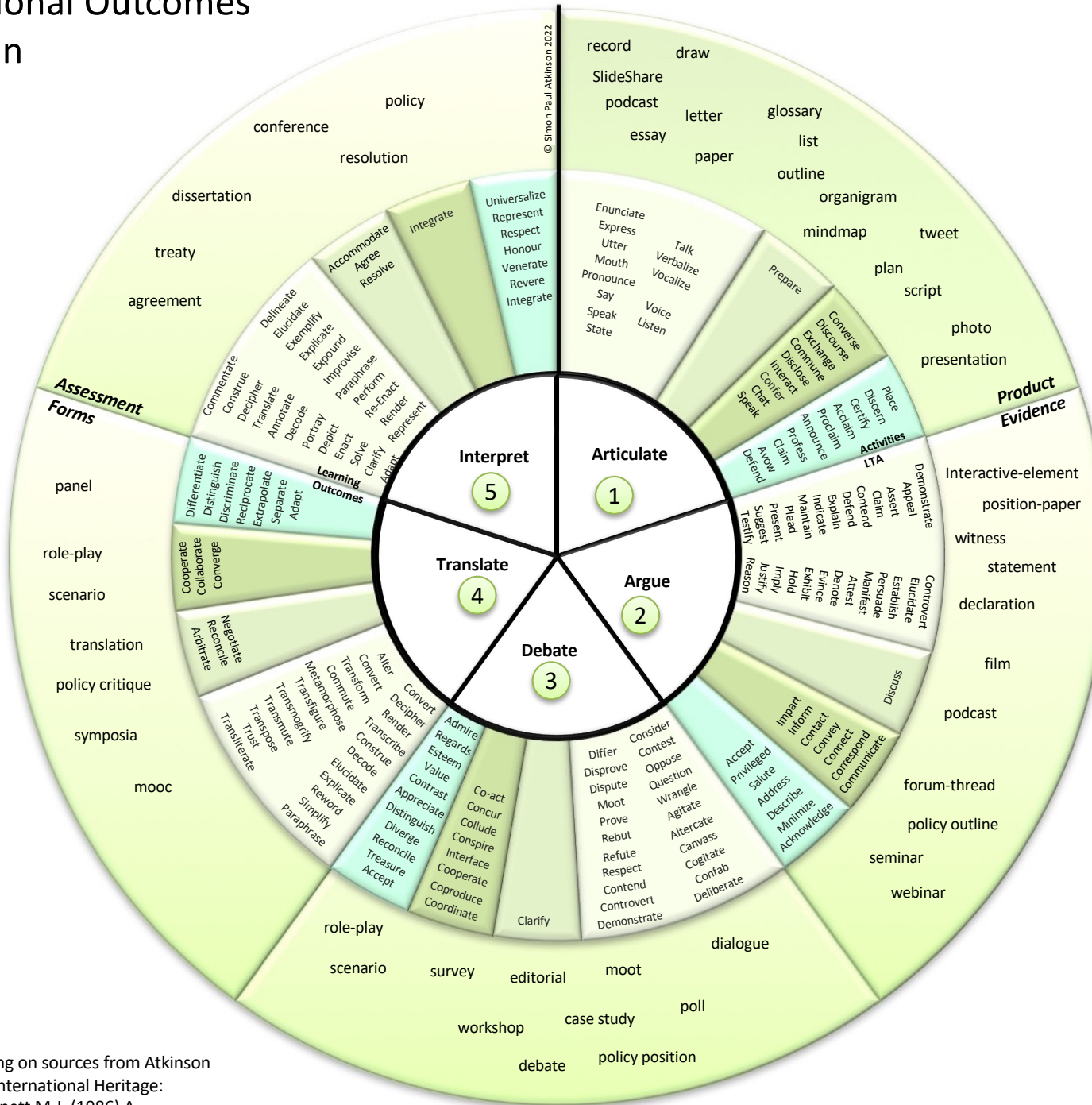
**Articulate** – the ability to express one’s own perspective clearly and distinctly

**Argue** – ability to cite evidence to represent a point of view with clarity in counterpoint and exchange with others

**Debate** – ability to express in a formal manner a given perspective and recognize others perspectives.

**Translate** – ability to articulate a perspective with reference to alternatives by way of comparison, metaphor or figurative forms

**Interpret** – ability to explain other’s perspectives with appropriate respect with reference to evidence and experience.
